

<u>Call for Participation: IJIS Artificial Intelligence Working Group</u> <u>Submission Deadline: March 29th, 2024</u>

This Call for Participation (CFP) is an invitation for your involvement in the IJIS Institute's Artificial Intelligence Working Group (AI WG).

Working groups are constituted to provide input and recommendations to the Institute and to other organizations on specific topical areas related to a single long-term project or task. All Members are welcome to serve on any committee, and committee leadership ideally constitutes representatives from both the public and private sectors to provide a balanced perspective on the areas of interest.

The mission of the AI Working Group:

The IJIS AI working group, under the guidance of the IJIS Technical and Architecture (I-TAC) Advisory Committee, will address the pros and cons of the use of Artificial Intelligence and associated technologies for government agencies and the private sector by providing useful information to help them make their decisions on utilizing AI-based technologies in their organization. The working group will also address how to address the privacy, security, and misuse of AI-based technology.

Objectives of the AI Working Group:

The AI WG will be corporate-neutral in activities and work products by providing industry-based information that can be used by executives, practitioners, and technologists in government, industry, national standards practice associations, and research/academic organizations as they make strategic decisions regarding artificial intelligence strategy. The AI WG will achieve these goals via work products including white papers, position papers, technology/standards/architecture reviews, webinar sessions, conference presentations, convening roundtables and summits, and social media outreach.

Working Group Composition and Member Responsibilities:

The AI WG will be composed of a chairperson, a vice-chairperson, a secretary, and working group members from IJIS Institute member organizations, alliance partners, government associates, and academia. Any individual who has skills and experience that will assist the AI WG in achieving its identified mission in this effort or maintains an interest in this dynamic and important subject area is welcome to join by submitting a response to the regular calls for participation issued by the working group. All our committees have monthly conference calls. To maintain membership in the committee, members are required to attend 8 of the 10 scheduled calls each year, attend a minimum of one of the two scheduled in-person meetings each year, and coordinate and produce work products which will consist of white papers, webinar sessions, conference presentations, convening roundtables and summits, and social media outreach.

Participation Requirements and Skills Needed:

The IJIS Institute seeks practitioners and industry representatives who are operational experts and/or IT professionals uniquely qualified to identify operational opportunities/challenges related to AI.
